Timeline updates: how the *Tai-Pan* roster changes

worked on *One Last Dance* on and off for the past six years. When I got the most recent newsletter I was looking over the timeline section an realized that a new character had been introduced between the time that I started the story and now.

Just for a moment, I forgot that *One Last Dance* had just been published, and I thought of a way to work a quick reference to the character into that story. Then I remembered that *One Last Dance* was done, finished, no longer available for revision. It is a funny feeling to have worked on a story for so long and made as many changes to it as I did and then to realize that it is finished. No more tinkering allowed.

Change is one of the meta-issues of working on a shared universe project. I started the story in 1996 with the cast of characters that was available at that time. Throughout several revisions, I requested new copies of the timeline as I realized how much time had gone by and I would discover 'new' characters that had been added in the meantime.

I put the 'new' in parenthesis because, even at the time I discovered them, the characters had sometimes been around the project for two, even three years before the creator and editorial board figured out where to start them on the timeline.

Date-specific crew rosters, on the other hand are created as needed by various authors trying to get a handle on which characters work together. This has been more critical with the Tai-Pan crew than with any of the other project ships until recently. Though we have had several requests for timeline specific rosters for the Iktome and I know that one contributor had started on such project, to help us keep track of the various comings and goings of the pi-

rate crew. The other two project ships are so large that there is a lot of room for new character creation and less need (at this point) to really closely manage which characters normally work together.

This brings me to the latest feature offered to contributors. Gene has put together several crew rosters for the Tai-Pan from different points on the timeline. These are available for your use when writing stories (or brainstorming about which characters would interact with who).

The updated rosters and the timeline also allow authors to note when a new character appears on the scene. If you are half-way though a story set on the Tai-Pan, take a moment to look and see if new characters have been added since the inception of your story. It may be that you can help a fellow contributor get their character's foot in the door by mentioning the character in your story or by replacing and older (and well used character) with someone new who has not has as much exposure to our audience.

Assembling date-specific crew rosters can be very time consuming. When it is done right, it is an accurate reflection of both the timeline and what we have printed in the issues so far. If you have put together your own version for a story in progress, let Gene know. We can always use the help.
